

**RPS Landscape SIG
Coastal Exploration West Cornwall
2 and 3 November 2019**

VERY IMPORTANT NOTES

Please note – locations on both days of this shoot involve cliff walks and shooting from cliff tops, short steep walks to the beach and beaches with large boulders. Regrettably, the days are unsuitable for those with mobility issues or a fear of heights.

It is recommended that you bring a picnic lunch as the days are short and this will maximise shooting time.

To ensure you get to the correct place please use the co-ordinates. Most sat nav systems allow these to be input – check before you travel that you know how to do this please.

Saturday 2 November

St Michaels Mount 9:00

Park at 50.123467 -5.4738951

Depart for Pendeen Cove 11:00

Park by the lighthouse

Parking at 50.164897 -5.670996

Postcode TR19 7ED

This is a steep walk down to the beach and the jetty onto the beach is very steep but with a handrail

Depart For Land's End 13:30

Parking at 50.0647771 – 5.7127034
Postcode TR17 7AA

Here we will be shooting off the cliff tops onto the light house
and along the coast until sunset.

Sunday 3 November

Sunrise 07:14
Sunset 16:55

High tide 09:01 5.7m at St Ives

Godrevy lighthouse 9:30

Parking at 50.235743 -5.392080

Do not park in the main car park but continue along the road
until a parking area just before some barriers.

We will be shooting here at high tide so it is important to be
wary of waves breaking over the rocks and to ensure you have
an escape route to the south at all times. Shooting off the cliff
tops is possible but the views are better from the beach.

Depart for Botallack mines 11:30

Parking at 50.142846 -5.6907525
Postcode TR19 7QG

Here we will be shooting images of the old mining buildings.
The walking is fairly easy but the views are from high exposed
cliffs.

Depart for Porth Nanven 14:30

Parking at 50.118935 -5.699589
Postcode TR19 7NT

Sunset shoot off the beach and rock structures. The beach is covered in large boulders. It is a short walk from the car to the beach but the beach is not easy to move over.
